Your OUT-OF-NETWORK Physical Therapy Insurance Benefits:

- 1. Call the number on the back of your insurance card. Select the option that will allow you to speak with a customer service provider, not an automated system.
- 2. Ask for your physical therapy benefits/outpatient rehabilitation benefits (it may include occupation therapy, speech therapy).
- 3. Emphasize that you will be seeing an OUT-OF-NETWORK physical therapy provider.
- 4. For your information, these questions would be helpful to have answered by your insurance company:
 - a. Do I have a deductable (out of network)?

How much is my deductable? How much have I met of it?

- b. What is my co-insurance after my deductable has been meet?
- c. Do I have a co-pay?
- d. Do I need a physician written prescription for PT?
- e. Do I need pre-authorization for PT services?
 - i. If so, is there an expiration date?
- f. Do I need to fill out a special form for my claim?
- g. Do I have a dollar amount or visit number limitation for PT?
 - i. If so, what happens after I meet that?
- h. How can I submit my claim(s): by mail, fax, email?
 - i. What information will I need to have for my claim?
- i. How soon after my claim will I receive something from you?
